1981. After the death of Doña Modesta, her sons David, Stephen, Henry, Victor, and John divided their corporation and operated their own Gaisano Malls.

Run today by second-generation Gaisanos, their malls now include Metro Gaisano, Gaisano Country Malls, and the Gaisano Capital Group.










19th and 30th Floor Plan (Sky Garden)








41st and 46th Floor Plan






42<sup>nd</sup> Floor Plan (Sky Garden)
